

College Level Examination Program / CLEP

CLEP is a way to earn college credit for what the test-taker already learned and may shorten the college experience. Information regarding CLEP examinations is available by calling Amy Smith at 570-662-4204.

We participate in the national College Level Examination Program (CLEP). Mansfield University grants credit for CLEP SUBJECT examinations, but does not grant credit for the CLEP GENERAL examination. Subject examinations are available in the areas of business, composition, education, foreign languages, humanities, mathematics, science, and social science.

MU Students: You must first complete the "[Request to Take CLEP Exam Form](#)" and obtain permission from the Registrar's Office (224 South Hall) to take the exam. You must register and make payment for the exam(s) online at <http://clep.collegeboard.org/register/exam>. You will receive a registration ticket. You must bring the registration ticket with you on the day of the exam. Upon arrival you will be required to show one form of ID.
